

There is a lot of activity at the Community Center as well, with card and mahjong players along with many of our Pelican Marsh community groups and clubs.


Fitness is spooling up again and it looks like 2022 will set a new benchmark for resident engagement with our amenities and activities.



### New year's resolutions and unrealistic optimism

New Year's Day is an especially big day for unrealistic optimism. Many of us will show up at the Fitness Center with a "resolution high" — the warm glow that comes from deciding you

are going to change for the better. Psychologists have found that this resolution high leads you to underestimate how external forces and other events will undermine your motivation. You fail to

plan for obstacles and expect that it will be easy to act on good intentions.

Unfortunately, the stronger the intention, the more likely we are to *miss* opportunities to act on it. We also might fail

to seek out the support we need to stick to our intentions. Ironically, interventions designed to strengthen a person's commitment only increase the rate of optimistic prediction, not the behavior itself.

If, as trainers, we focus your motivational strategies by getting you psyched up about the benefits of getting fit and committing to working out,

you might feel good in the moment, but you won't change your behavior.


Research shows that anticipating how much we will later regret skipping a workout motivates us above and beyond imagining the positive outcomes of exercising itself (Abraham & Sheeran 2004).

Play out the consequences in your mind of your decision to exercise or to skip it. When you find yourself contemplating a workout, you should ask yourself, "How will I feel tomorrow about the decision I made today?" -51



### **Massage and Arthritis**

Consider adding massage to your toolbox when dealing with knee arthritis for an effective, integrative approach to reducing pain and improving function. In a small, randomized study of 68 adults with osteoarthritis of the knee, researchers at the Prevention Research Center at Yale University School of Medicine in New Haven, Connecticut, found that subjects who received regular hour-long massage therapy treatments had improved flexibility and range of motion and less pain within 8 weeks of beginning treatment.

Numerous studies have shown that massage relieves chronic low-back pain and musculoskeletal disorders, but no prior research has focused on whether massage could help arthritis sufferers.

"The very significant therapeutic response over 8 weeks of therapy persisted 8 weeks later. Two months after the last massage, [the subjects] were still significantly better than baseline and significantly better than the control group. That exceeded our expectations," David Katz, MD, senior study author, associate adjunct professor of public health at Yale and director of the Prevention Research Center, told HealthDay news.

Researchers explain that there are two possible explanations for the positive outcome. "Sensory input [from the massage] competes with pain input in the spinal cord, travels faster and blocks pain symptoms," said Katz. Massage also has a more significant longterm healing effect by increasing circulation. Improved circulation "brings an influx of cells to clean out the debris and facilitates, to whatever extent possible, bone and cartilage remodeling."

Massage is a great option and does not carry the risks of adverse side effects associated with pharmaceuticals; it may also be less expensive.

This study appeared in Archives of Internal Medicine (2006; 166, 2533–38).

### **Safety first**

We have a lot of bikers and walkers in Pelican Marsh, which is absolutely wonderful, but it's important to stay safe! There have been a few near accidents because people were not exercising precaution.

Below are some safety tips, provided by Johns Hopkins, that we encourage you to adopt:

• Be seen. Wear neon, fluorescent or bright colors when riding and wear something that reflects light (reflective shoes, reflective tape, etc.).

• Pay attention. Do not wear headphones so that you can hear the traffic and pedestrians around you. Never text and ride.

• Ride in the same direction as traffic and stay as far to the right as possible. Use bike lanes whenever you can.

• If riding between the hours of sunset and sunrise, Florida Law requires that the front of the bike be equipped with a headlight lamp that exhibits

a white light visible for 500 feet, and the rear of the bike be equipped with a tail lamp and reflector visible for 600 feet.

• Make sure all equipment on the bicycle is in working order (brakes, gears, tires, etc.).
