## Community update

As I write this, the winter holiday season fast approaches and we are seeing many of our friends and neighbors back from points north to enjoy the great weather here at Pelican Marsh. We had a wonderful Welcome Back party, this time with a rock 'n' roll theme. Lynn and her team gave us another amazing night of memories.

### Entry gate construction

As of this writing, the CDD has opened the Vanderbilt gate and closed the Airport gate for reconstruction. We anticipate that Airport will be closed through season. Please advise your visitors to use the U.S. 41 and Vanderbilt Beach Road entrances.

### Road widening status

Collier County has updated the community on the Vanderbilt Beach Road widening project. At this time, they are projecting a construction start date of May 1, 2024. The Airport-Pulling Road project is expected to start construction about 18 months after Vanderbilt Beach Road. We are continuing to speak to



our commissioner, Chris Hall, about landscaping the medians of these widened roads. He has been supportive, but the commissioners have not yet voted on the issue. We will continue to follow this closely.

### Amenity expansion

The Foundation has received some good news from Collier County. After a lengthy evaluation, we have been told that the County will allow us to build three more pickleball courts and a 500-square-foot expansion of the Community Center with our current parking capacity. The Board plans to have a

report regarding construction plans ready for discussion at its January meeting.

### Refresh and renew

We have been improving the landscape around the tennis courts. A combination of pavers and synthetic turf have replaced the shrubbery along the eastern side of the courts. Some of the older pots and urns have been removed, others cleaned and freshly planted. Paul and his crew have done a great job upgrading the look of this area.

### Community restaurant

Courtside has been doing great.

They plan to be open seven days a week just after New Year's Day. The food is terrific and music nights have been super popular.

### Board application deadline

Finally, while the Annual Meeting is at the end of March, the deadline for filing an application to serve on the Pelican Marsh Foundation Board of Directors is Feb. 2. Three seats on the Board will be open. I encourage anyone with an interest in serving the community to run for one of these seats. 🐦



Lastly, if you are coming from the tennis courts to the pickleball courts, please make sure you clean your shoes thoroughly. We do not want any clay on our pickleball courts or in the Fitness Center or Community Center. It will damage the surfaces and make for an unsafe environment.

Let us get out there and show off our court shoes with some fancy footwork.

Remember to always play with a little bit of attitude and lots of gratitude.

# Saving lives in Pelican Marsh

Understanding AEDs and their vital presence in community spaces

Nestled within the serene beauty of Pelican Marsh, a crucial set of lifesaving devices quietly stand ready to serve the community in times of need. Automatic External Defibrillators (AEDs) have become an essential component of any community's safety infrastructure, capable of providing critical assistance during sudden cardiac emergencies.

With Pelican Marsh's commitment to the well-being of its residents, the strategic placement of AEDs throughout the community — by the tennis courts, bocce courts and fitness center — exemplifies the neighborhood's dedication



to proactive health and safety measures.

Understanding the significance of these devices is paramount to appreciating the

profound impact they can have on preserving life within the community. An AED is a portable electronic device designed to administer a therapeutic shock

to a person experiencing sudden cardiac arrest (SCA). These devices are equipped with intelligent sensors and voice prompts that guide the user through the steps of providing potentially life-saving treatment, making them accessible even to those without specialized medical training. By analyzing the heart's rhythm and delivering a controlled electric shock, if necessary, AEDs play a critical role in restoring the heart's natural rhythm and increasing the chances of survival during a cardiac emergency.

While the presence of AEDs in key community areas serves as a crucial safety measure,

empowering residents with the knowledge of how to operate these devices is equally important. Offering periodic training sessions on basic life support and AED usage can equip members of the community with the confidence and skills needed to effectively respond to cardiac emergencies. By fostering a culture of preparedness and proactive intervention, Pelican Marsh cultivates a community where residents are not just beneficiaries of safety measures but active participants in ensuring the well-being of their neighbors. can traverse the neighborhood with peace of mind and a sense of belonging.

In Florida, bike lanes are designated portions of the roadway intended for the exclusive use

of bicyclists. These lanes serve a pivotal role in facilitating safe and efficient cycling, providing cyclists with a dedicated space that minimizes conflicts with motor vehicles and pedestrians. With the aim of enhancing overall road safety and fostering a culture of shared road usage, the creation and maintenance of bike lanes underscore the state's commitment to promoting sustainable and healthy transportation alternatives.

Florida law stipulates that bicyclists utilizing bike lanes possess the same rights and responsibilities as drivers of motor vehicles. This includes

adhering to traffic signals, yielding to pedestrians when crossing sidewalks or crosswalks and following designated rules of the road. Additionally, motorists must yield to cyclists when merging into or crossing bike lanes, ensuring a seamless and secure flow of traffic. By understanding and respecting these right-of-way regulations, both cyclists and motorists contribute to a safer and more harmonious road-sharing environment.

In addition to adhering to the established bike lane laws, Florida encourages cyclists to prioritize their safety through

the use of appropriate safety gear such as helmets and reflective clothing. It is also recommended that cyclists equip their bikes with front and rear lights to enhance their visibility, particularly during low-light conditions. Furthermore, maintaining a vigilant awareness of their surroundings and exercising caution when navigating intersections and crosswalks are essential practices that contribute to a secure and enjoyable cycling experience.
