

Community Development District

As you may know, the Pelican Marsh Community Development District (CDD) is a governmental entity tasked with planning, financing, constructing, operating and maintaining infrastructure projects within

Pelican Marsh and Tiburon. Services provided to our community include landscaping, road maintenance, water management, access control, street lighting and irrigation.

The CDD is managed by a five-member board of supervisors and employs a district manager, an operations manager, an access control manager, a district engineer and a district attorney, as well as a team of workers we've all likely seen around the community engaged in landscaping and road maintenance projects.

Entry gate renovations

The CDD has released its schedule for the renovation of the three manned gates and gatehouses at Pelican Marsh. The plan is to begin work on the Vanderbilt Beach Road gate on March 27 with completion scheduled for June 26. Work at the Airport Pulling Road gate is scheduled to begin on July 10, and renovation of the U.S. 41 gate is slated to begin just before Thanksgiving.

Four of the five members of the CDD board of supervisors live in Pelican Marsh: Chairman Ed Walsh, Vice Chairman Tim Jackoboice, Treasurer John Minty and Bob Giannetti. These guys work hard for our community. If you see them around Pelican Marsh, please tell them how much you appreciate their service.



We are now in the middle of our busiest season ever. It is great to see how active our courts are. Play starts under the lights on many mornings (yes, we have many pickleball court reservations starting at 6:30 a.m. and a few tennis players practicing their serves!) and ends under the lights on most evenings. The new LED lights provide better lighting and have made playing at night much more enjoyable.

Our league teams are in the midst of their winter seasons with 17 tennis teams and four pickleball teams competing against other clubs in the area. We publish their schedules on a weekly basis. Come out and support your fellow Pelican Marsh players.

In January, we organized the first Minor League Pickleball team event. We drafted 32 players onto eight teams of two women and two men. After a fun-filled afternoon of pickleball, congratulations go to the winning team, "Kitchen Disaster," captained by Olaf Rintsch and players Karen Mecadon, Marell Kowalski and David Spiega.

February brought several exciting events to the courts, with a Valentine's Day Mixer on the tennis courts and the return of the Dink and Glow (Mardi Gras Edition) on the pickleball courts. We had a tennis exhibition to benefit the YMCA of Naples. Additionally, we geared up for Club

Coming to Pelican Marsh on March 10 will be the Naples Pro League, which features the best tennis pros in Naples. Also coming in March is the St. Patrick's Day Four-Court Tennis Challenge.

Pickleball has been the fastest-growing sport in America. Last year, I reported that our pickleball program has grown from a few dozen players to over 450 active players. This year, we have over 650 players. More than 250 of those players are also tennis players. The data for these numbers comes from CourtReserve. our court reservation software. It is a great tool for the

residents to manage reservations, events, clinics, etc.

Rules to follow for a positive workout experience.



5. Dress appropriately. Wear appropriate workout clothes and shoes, and make sure you're not wearing anything that


could be offensive or inappropriate. Open-toed shoes are not permitted in the Fitness Center.





CREW Land & Water Trust

Have you heard of CREW? The CREW Land & Water Trust was established in 1989 as a nonprofit organization to coordinate the land acquisition, land management and public use of the 60,000acre Corkscrew Regional Ecosystem Watershed (CREW). 
On the morning of April 10, we will take a guided walk at the Bird Rookery Swamp Trail. We will hike "the loop," which is a 12-mile hike.

The Bird Rookery Swamp Trail officially opened in July 2011. It offers 12 miles of hiking and biking trails, including a 1,500-foot boardwalk with wheelchair accessibility. A one-quarter-mile crushed shell path leads to a 1,500-foot boardwalk, then the trails become ground level, sandy/grassy, relatively

flat berms with swamp on both sides.

The trails are old tram roads used when the area was logged many years ago. The maple cypress swamp is home to alligators, otters, Florida panthers, bobcats, white-tailed deer, and more. There is an abundance of songbirds that frequent the cypress trees along the boardwalk, as well as the many raptors and wading birds found along the trails.
